71ST Annual Indiana Elks State Bowling Association Handicap Tournament @ Bloomington, IN Lodge #446

Only members of the B. P. O. Elks, in good standing or their spouse, are eligible to participate. Every entrant will be called upon, by the Tournament Committee, to exhibit their membership card. All scores of bowlers who are not bona fide Elk members or their spouse will not be considered for prizes.

HANDICAP PERCENTAGE USED: Handicap will be calculated on an individual basis in each event. Each bowler shall receive 100% of the difference between their average and 225, with no limit of pins per game.

AVERAGE: ENTRANTS WILL USE THEIR HIGHEST LAST SEASON'S (SUMMER LEAGUE ACCEPTED) U.S.B.C. SANCTIONED LEAGUE AVERAGE AS RECORDED IN THE LOCAL U.S.B.C. ASSOCIATION RECORDS AND WHICH SHALL BE CERTIFIED BY THE TEAM CAPTAIN. A minimum of 21 games must have been bowled to establish an average. If current 21 game league average, AS OF 1/7/19 is 10 or more pins above last season's average, current average must be used. If no average last three years, use highest recorded sanctioned average, 21 games or more, as of date of entry. All others will bowl assuming a 170 average. If an entrant has not bowled 21 games on the entry date but will have 21 games bowled on bowling date, list the present average and change at tournament office before bowling in each event. No tournament prize winnings during the previous twelve months need be reported. If an entrant reports a higher average than his true average, no correction will be made and he will be handicapped accordingly. If a lower average is submitted, he/she and the team, collectively will be disqualified. **NO ADJUSTMENT AFTER ENTRANT HAS BOWLED, THE BOWLER is responsible for the average used on the score sheet- SO CHECK THE AVERAGE ON YOUR SCORE SHEET BEFORE YOU BOWL.** All entrants are subject to adjustment average in accordance with the U.S.B.C. rule 31 ge.

ALL U.S.B.C. ENTRANTS will be requested to display their current membership card and/or spouse card; the Tournament Management will enforce this rule.

MULTIPLE PARTICIPATION: An entrant may bowl only one time in the singles event. Double participation allowed in the doubles event but one player in the lineup must be different, for the four-player team event, at least two players in the lineup must be different to allow entering more than once. In cases of emergency, the host Lodge will provide substitutes in the team or doubles events. Cash prizes will be awarded on handicap in each event at a ratio of at least one for every eight entries. All prizes awarded. The payout distribution to be determined by the Tournament Management.

ENTRY FEES: The entry fee for each person, for each event, shall be \$18.50 which includes \$8.00 prize fee, \$8.50 for bowling, \$1.00 for tournament expenses and \$1.00 donation to Indiana Elks Association Cancer Research Charities. The Entry Fee is to be paid when the entry is filed. **ALL PRIZE FEES TO BE RETURNED 100% IN CASH.**

U.S.B.C. MORAL SUPPORT SANCTIONED: U.S.B.C. members may participate in this tournament with award recognition being automatically extended. Eligible non U.S.B.C. members may qualify for U.S.B.C. award recognition by purchasing a U.S.B.C. associate membership card before participation. The U.S.B.C. Associate card is \$21.00. Upon receipt of dues, the Congress will issue the specified unattached individual membership card. **THIS TOURNAMENT IS CONDUCTED UNDER THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE U.S.B.C. TOURNAMENTS.**

ANY VIOLATION OR MISCONDUCT on the lanes, during the tournament games, or the delaying of such games by any of the participants to cause delay in the schedule of the tournament, the Tournament Manager is authorized to rule participants off the lanes.
